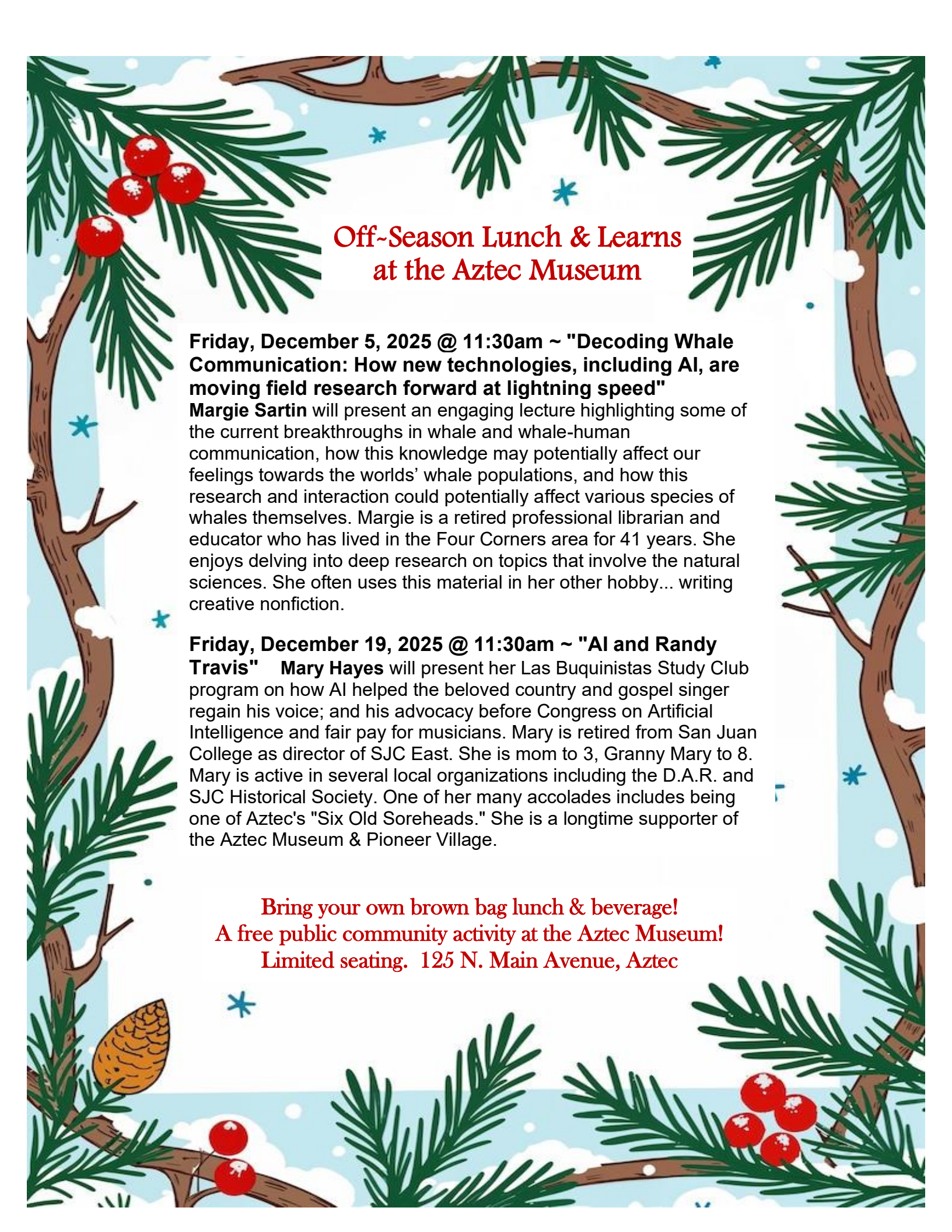




Off-Season Lunch & Learns at the Aztec Museum
